

13. L.L. Quidore House—(cc 1882) It is possible a log structure was already on the property when it was purchased from the Sitlingtons in 1882, and the subsequent frame house was built around the log house. The house was the home of the well-known physician, Dr. Leroy Quidore. When Dr. Quidore died in 1885, he left his wife to raise five children on her own. She opened a millinery shop to support her family, and two of her daughters, Mame and Ida, subsequently taught school in the McDowell area.
