

22. The McDowell Mill—(Fleisher’s Mill) Completed in 1911 by E. Ashby Hammer. His obituary in The Recorder included the lines: “He gave employment to more people than any other man in this county. His last effort was building a flour mill at McDowell which he had completed about the time he took sick.” The mill was used until 1940, even after a flood washed out the dam and a tractor was used to power it. The 3-storey mill building has served as a general store and, at one time, a movie theater, before it was renovated as a private residence.
