

## First Generation

1. **Loftus PULLIN**<sup>1-3</sup> was born about 1720.<sup>4-5</sup> Location: Bullpasture, 1 mile above Clover Creek in 1746.<sup>6</sup> Location: in Cowpasture area, Highland County, VA lived there when the first surveyors laid out tracts in 1746.<sup>7</sup> Location: in Bullpasture River Valley, Highland County, VA Among the earliest settlers in the Bullpasture Valley, Highland County about 1750.<sup>8</sup> Individual Note: Appointed by the court to help clear a road from Estill's mill to the head of the Calfpasture in 1751.<sup>9</sup> Individual Note: Worked on a road from Estill's mill to William Wilson's mill on Bolar Run in 1753.<sup>10</sup> Location: in Cowpasture Valley, VA in 1758.<sup>11</sup> Property: Land 4 miles south of McDowell, VA was from original grant in 1743 then further granted in 1758.<sup>12</sup> Property: sold 240 acres on the Calfpasture River to James Shaw for five shillings on 19 Aug 1760 in Augusta County, VA.<sup>13</sup> He died in 1801; at the age of 81.<sup>14-15</sup> Estate: Left personal property of \$522.32.<sup>4</sup> Military: Fought in the French-Indian and Revolutionary Wars.<sup>5</sup>

Loftus PULLIN and Ann Jane USHER were married about 1750.<sup>16-17</sup> Family Note: James Knox became her guardian.<sup>18</sup> **Ann Jane USHER**<sup>19-20</sup>, daughter of Edward USHER and PERRY, was born (date unknown).

- +18   ix. **John S. PULLIN**, born 1810, Bath County, VA; married Nancy PRAY, 1835; died 1861.

9. **Samuel PULLIN**<sup>4,22,43</sup> (Loftus-1) was born in 1770 in Augusta County, VA.<sup>44-45</sup> Property: Conveyed two story house and surrounding acreage 4 miles south of McDowell, VA to son John H. on 21 Sep 1841.<sup>12</sup> Property: Owned real estate valued at \$4,000 in 1850.<sup>46</sup> Occupation: Farmer in 1850.<sup>46</sup> He died in 1858; at the age of 88.<sup>4</sup>

**Nancy HENRY**<sup>4,47</sup> died before 1850; .<sup>46</sup>
