Location: Among the earliest settlers in the Bullpasture Valley, Highland County; located on broad bottom about 1750.¹ Individual Note: Appointed by the court to help clear a road from Estill's mill to the head of the Calfpasture in 1751.² Individual Note: Worked on a road from Estill's mill to William Wilson's mill on Bolar Run in 1753.³ Property: purchased 260 acres on Cowpasture River from James Botkin for five shillings on 19 May 1767 in Augusta County, VA.⁴ Agriculture: Produced 478 pounds of hemp in 1767.⁵ **Robert CARLILE**^{4,6} died in 1802; .⁷

Helms, nephew in 1869.¹² She died in Jan 1869; paralysis at the age of 54 at Stonewall Township in Stonewall District, Highland County, VA.¹² Individual Note: unmarried.¹²
