County, VA on 15 Aug 1758.<sup>23</sup> Property: 105 acres on the Cowpasture River deeded to William Stewart for 20 pounds in Augusta County, VA on 16 May 1759.<sup>24</sup> Property: 100 acres on Cowpasture River deeded to James Shaw for 10 pounds in Augusta County, VA on 16 Aug 1759.<sup>25</sup> Property: 100 acres on the Cowpasture River deeded to James Clemons for 15 pounds, 2 shillings, and 6 pence in Augusta County, VA on 16 Feb 1762.<sup>26</sup> He died in 1777; at the age of 48 in Fayette County, PA.<sup>18</sup>

4. **Samuel WILSON**<sup>5,27-29</sup> (James-1) was born in 1730 in Lancaster County, PA.<sup>2,27</sup> Location: in Doe Hill, VA in 1758.<sup>9</sup> Location: moved to western Augusta County, VA about 1758.<sup>9</sup> Property: 200 acres deeded from George and Elizabeth Wilson on the Bullpasture River for 40 pounds; part of tract deeded to George by James Trimble; in Augusta County, VA on 15 Aug 1758.<sup>30</sup> Property: 63 acres in Bullpasture River Valley, Augusta County, VA on 16 Feb 1768.<sup>31</sup> Property: 66 acres in Bullpasture River Valley, Augusta County, VA on 16 Feb 1768.<sup>31</sup> Property: 97 acres in Jackson's River area, Augusta County, VA on 20 Feb 1768.<sup>31</sup> Property: 86 acres in Bullpasture River Valley, Augusta County, VA on 3 May 1773.<sup>32</sup> Military: in Aug 1774 Was captain of a Highland company of 27 men as part of Colonel Andrew Lewis' Augusta County Militia Regiment.<sup>28,33-35</sup> He signed a will on 22 Aug 1774 in Augusta County, VA.<sup>29,35-36</sup> He died on 10 Oct 1774; at the age of 44 killed, the bullet first passing through the powder horn hanging from his neck in Point Pleasant, VA.<sup>35,37-38</sup> Estate: in 1777 His estate showed personal property valued at nearly \$1000.<sup>39</sup> Samuel was buried in Point Pleasant, VA.<sup>35</sup>

Elizabeth Jane WILSON and William BLAGG were married in 1773.<sup>50</sup> **William BLAGG**<sup>48,50-54</sup>, son of BLAGG, was born on 8 Mar 1740.<sup>50,55</sup> Property: owned 283 acres lying on Mecham's River; purchased for 25 pounds Virginia currency in Albemarle County, VA between 1772 and 1777.<sup>56</sup> Property: paid 25 pounds to William Smith for 283 acres in Albemarle County, VA on 10 Sep 1772.<sup>57</sup> Property: sold 283 acres to William Smith in Albemarle County, VA on 13 Nov 1777.<sup>58</sup> Location: in Doe Hill area, VA 1 mile NW in 1780.<sup>59</sup> Location: in Doe Hill area, VA Moved to Doe Hill, VA from Albemarle County, VA about 1781.<sup>60</sup> Property: Survey of 81 acres in Augusta County on the head of the west

Two male descendants of Caleb and two male descendants of William had Y-DNA testing performed. The two descendants of William, James Abner and Gary Stuart Blagg agreed on 34 of the 39 alleles tested that were common to both. The two Caleb descendants agreed entirely with each other for all their 37 alleles tested, but only agreed with 17 of the 37 tested that were common to both of William's male descendants. Caleb and William's descendants were also of different haplogroups, further proving their lack of relationship.<sup>72</sup>

will on 12 Jun 1810 in Pendleton County, VA.<sup>77</sup> He died on 3 Jul 1810; at the age of 52 in Pendleton County, VA.<sup>18-19,74</sup> Occupation: Farmer .<sup>18</sup> Military: Served in Captain Robert McCoy's Company.<sup>18</sup> Property: inherited all lands per father's will dated 1802.<sup>13</sup>
