1. **Andrew LOCKRIDGE**¹⁻⁴ was born on 10 Apr 1730 in Spotsylvania County, VA.^{3,5} Military: on 18 Mar 1768 Captain in Augusta Militia at Battle of Point Pleasant in Augusta County, VA.³ Location: in Bullpasture, below Poverty about 1774.⁶⁻⁷ Individual Note: on 13 Apr 1778 in Augusta County, VA signer of a petition to establish a new county.⁸ Military: on 19 Aug 1778 Major, 2nd Battalion, Augusta Militia; fought in War of Independence in Augusta County, VA.^{3,5} Property: owns 2 blacks over 16 years, 4 blacks under 16 years, 13 horses, and 34 cattle in Augusta County, VA in 1787.⁹ Family Note: in 1787 two males 16-21 years in Augusta County, VA.⁹ He signed a will on 7 Jan 1791 in Augusta County, VA.² He died in 1791; at the age of 61 in Burnsville, VA.¹⁰⁻¹¹ Andrew was buried in Lockridge Cemetery, Stonewall District, Highland County, VA.⁵ Military: commanded Fort Dinwiddie in Jackson's River area, Augusta County, VA.¹²

Andrew LOCKRIDGE and Jean "Jane" GRAHAM were married on 7 Apr 1762 in Augusta County, VA.^{3,13} **Jean "Jane" GRAHAM**¹⁴⁻¹⁶, daughter of John GRAHAM, was born in 1742.⁵ She died in 1796; at the age of 54.⁵ She was buried in Lockridge Cemetery, Stonewall District, Highland County, VA.⁵

Andrew LOCKRIDGE and Jean GRAHAM had the following children:

Property: owns 4 horses and 5 cattle at Calfpasture in Augusta County, VA in 1782.¹⁷ **William LOCKRIDGE**^{2,18-20} (Andrew-1) died in 1798; in Bath County, VA.^{10,18} He signed a will on 10 Aug 1798 in Bath County, VA.¹⁸ Estate: on 27 Dec 1798 in Bath County, VA inventory: wagon, 4 horses, 21 cattle, 9 sheep, 10 geese, 2 negros, 4 stacks of hay, furniture, and farm implements .²¹

William LOCKRIDGE and Elizabeth BENSON were married in Aug 1796 in Bath County, VA.^{18,22-23} **Elizabeth BENSON**^{18-20,24}, daughter of Mathias BENSON and Margaret , was born (date unknown).

LOCKRIDGE**³⁰⁻³¹ was born in 1821 in Virginia.³⁰⁻³¹ Military: in 1862–1863 Company H, 14th Virginia Cavalry, CSA; KIA below Winchester; also in Company I, 19th Virginia Cavalry, CSA.³¹ He died on 4 Sep 1864; at the age of 43 of battle wounds in Winchester, VA.³¹ Military: Colonel, 127th Virginia Militia.³¹ Office Held: member, Virginia House of Delegates³¹

9. **Sarah Jenny LOCKRIDGE**^{2,10,32} (Andrew-1) was born (date unknown).

Sarah Jenny LOCKRIDGE and David KINCAID were married in Jun 1800 in Bath County, VA.^{10,33} Agriculture: in 1850 190 acres improved, 90 acres unimproved land; farm value \$2,500, machinery value \$100, livestock value \$700 in Highland County, VA³⁴ **David KINCAID**^{10,35-38}, son of John KINCAID and Elizabeth , was born (date unknown).

10. **Rebecca LOCKRIDGE**^{2,10,39} (Andrew-1) was born (date unknown).

Minister: George Guthrie in 1793 .³⁹ Rebecca LOCKRIDGE and Benjamin KENNEDY were married on 27 Jul 1793 in Bath County, VA.³⁹ **Benjamin KENNEDY**³⁹ was born (date unknown).

12. **Robert LOCKRIDGE**^{2,40-45} (Andrew-1) was born in 1774 in Bath County, VA.^{10,41} Occupation: Farmer in 1850.⁴¹ Family Note: in 1850 lived with son, Washington .⁴¹ He died in 1856; at the age of 82.¹⁰

Minister: John Montgomery in 1799 .⁴⁴ Robert LOCKRIDGE and Mary "Polly" GWIN⁴³ were married on 1 Jan 1799 in Bath County, VA.^{10,44} Family Note: had 11 children .⁴⁶ **Mary "Polly" GWIN**^{43-45,47-48}, daughter of David GWIN and Jane CARLILE, was born (date unknown).
