Property: Patent for 100 acres on Black Thorn in Pendleton County, VA in 1761.¹ Property: surveyed land in Strait Creek area, Pendleton County, VA on 2 Nov 1795.² Location: in Strait Creek area, Pendleton County, VA in 1797–1799.³ Property: purchase of 50 acres for 20 pounds, adjoining his former land; no delivery shown at Strait Creek area in Pendleton County, VA on 7 Mar 1806.² Illness: weak in body in Jan 1824.⁴ **James TRIMBLE**^{2,4-7} signed a will on 21 Jan 1824 in Pendleton County, VA.⁴ He died in 1824; in Strait Creek area, Pendleton County, VA.⁸⁻⁹ He was buried in 1824 in Pendleton County, VA.⁹ in Harmon Seybert's place in the Meadow called Jeens Meadow; no monument. James was born in Scotland.⁹⁻¹¹ Military: Served in Revolutionary War under Cornwallis and was captured at Yorktown.⁹ Occupation: Farmer .⁹ Property: Seized a large and choice portion of Crabbottom and sold for a tidy sum.^{1,12} Location: Came to America from Scotland at age 16; fellow passenger with Lord Cornwallis .^{9,13} Last name was Turnbull. Came to America when he was 16 years old; was in the Revolutionary War and fought under the British flag. Cornwallis was his commander. James was captured at Yorktown. (NHHC, page 88)

Nancy TRIMBLE and John SAMPLES were married on 29 Sep 1805.^{18,20} **John SAMPLES**²¹⁻²⁶ was born on 7 Sep 1785 in Bath County, VA.²⁷⁻³² Location: in Strait Creek area, Highland County, VA in 1804.¹⁰ Location: in Strait Creek area, Pendleton County, VA 4 miles east of Monterey in 1809–1871.²⁶ Property: deeded house by William Moffett; 4 miles east of Monterey in Strait Creek area, Highland County, VA in 1809.²⁶ Tithable: Pendleton County, later to become Highland County, VA in 1822.³³ Agriculture: in 1850 70 acres improved, 260 acres unimproved land; farm value \$3,000, machinery value \$65, livestock value \$760 in Highland County, VA³⁴ Occupation: Farmer between 1850 and 1860.²⁸⁻²⁹ Property: Owned real estate valued at \$3,000 in 1850.²⁸ Property: Owned personal estate valued at \$250 in 1860.²⁹ Property: Owned real estate valued at \$3,000 in 1860.²⁹ Illness: Infirm in 1870.³⁰ He died on 29 Jan 1874; at the age of 88.^{20,35-36} Individual Note: May have been grandson to Samuel, who died in Augusta in 1776.²⁰ He was buried in Samples Cemetery, Strait Creek, Highland County, VA.¹⁹

United States Census, 25th District, Highland County, Virginia, 1850, taken 13 August (ref #87B) lists John Samples household in dwelling number 280. John was listed as a 66 year old male farmer with real estate valued at \$3,000. Also in the dwelling were Sarah (his wife) a female 56 years of age, Elijah a male with no occupation 26 years of age, Mary E. Douglas a female 23 years of age, and Sarah C. Douglas a female 3 years of age. John and Mary Douglas were listed as born in Bath County, Sarah C. was listed as born in Highland County, and Sarah Samples and Elijah were listed as born in Pendleton County, Virginia. (NARA) Elijah Samples is listed in the next dwelling with Harriet; which would suggest the Elijah in the next dwelling is John's son. Not sure who the Elijah in dwelling 280 is unless he was double counted.

Joseph was listed as a 64 year old male farmer with real estate valued at \$3,000. Also in the dwelling were Sarah (his wife) a female 63 years of age, Margaret a female 26 years of age, Joseph a male farmer 23 years of age, and Sarah a female 18 years of age. The elder Joseph was listed as born in New Jersey, Sarah was listed as born in Augusta County, and all others were listed as born in Pendleton County, Virginia. The younger Joseph was listed as attending school within the year. (NARA)

James was listed as a 55 year old male farmer with real estate valued at \$10,000. Also in the dwelling were Catharine (his wife) a female 62 years of age, James a male 27 years of age, Harvy a male 24 years of age, Elizabeth a female 26 years of age, Washington a male 22 years of age, Henry E. a male 18 years of age, and Mary A. a female 16 years of age. All were listed as born in Pendleton County except James who was listed as born in Augusta County, Virginia. Washington, Henry E. and Mary A. were listed as attending school within the year. (NARA)
