1. **Peter HULL Jr.**<sup>1-4</sup> was born in 1730.<sup>2</sup> Location: in Highland County, VA settled in Crab Apple Bottom, middle Crabbottom in 1765.<sup>5-6</sup> Military: between 1774 and 1775 2nd Augusta Militia; in American Revolution; was at Battle of Point Pleasant, Augusta County, VA.<sup>2,4,7</sup> Military: in 1779 commanded a company of Second Battalion, Augusta Militia.<sup>8</sup> Military: in 1779 commanded a troop of Cavalry in Yorktown Campaign.<sup>2</sup> Property: 50 acres from George and Margaret Rexrode to Peter Hull for 5 pounds at on the east side of Crab Apple Bottom in Crabbottom area, Pendleton County, VA on 4 Jan 1796.<sup>9</sup> Property: 395 acres from Peter and Barbary Hull to John Evans for 120 pounds at on the southeast side of Crab Apple Bottom in Crabbottom area, Pendleton County, VA on 7 Mar 1796.<sup>10</sup> Individual Note: about 1797 only justice from Highland area on the organization of county government in Pendleton County.<sup>11</sup> Property: 300 acres from Robert and Prudence Cunningham for 1,500 pounds in Crabbottom area, Pendleton County, VA on 2 Sep 1797.<sup>12</sup> Property: 97 acres to John Blankenship for 1 pound in Jackson's River area, Highland County, VA on 2 Sep 1800.<sup>13</sup> Property: 395 acres from John and Rebeccah Evans for 300 pounds in Crabbottom area, Pendleton County, VA on 2 Nov 1800.<sup>14</sup> Property: 59 acres to Henry Armoncost for 100 pounds in Crabbottom area, Pendleton County, VA on 2 Dec 1800.<sup>15</sup> Property: 461 acres to Balsler Hammer for 100 pounds in Crabbottom area, Pendleton County, VA on 1 Sep 1801.<sup>16</sup> Property: 338 3/4 acres to Jacob Greybill for 100 pounds in Crabbottom area, Pendleton County, VA on 5 Apr 1803.<sup>17</sup> He signed a will about 1817 in Pendleton County, VA.<sup>3</sup> Property: will named 15 slaves; others alluded to about 1817.<sup>3</sup> He died in Jan 1818; at the age of 88.<sup>1,18-20</sup> Peter was buried in 1818 in Hull Cemetery, Blue Grass area, Highland County, VA.<sup>7,18</sup> Office Held: Represented Pendleton County in General Assembly<sup>2</sup> Property: owned a major part of Crabbottom Valley.<sup>21</sup>

Peter HULL Jr. and Barbara PENNINGER were married in 1750.<sup>2,20</sup> **Barbara PENNINGER**<sup>3,13,22-26</sup> signed a will on 1 Feb 1828 in Pendleton County, VA.<sup>24</sup>

SITLINGTON**<sup>36,84,86,91-99</sup>, son of Robert SITLINGTON and Mary Margaret FEAMSTER, was born in 1781 in Augusta County, VA.<sup>86,100-103</sup> Religion: Donated the land for church on the Bullpasture; Central Union Meeting House in 1818.<sup>84</sup> Organization: on 20 May 1847 Member of the court to establish Highland County, Virginia.<sup>76</sup> Agriculture: in 1850 2000 acres improved, 14,000 acres unimproved land; farm value \$70,000, machinery value \$400, livestock value \$16,973 in Highland County, VA<sup>46</sup> Occupation: Farmer in 1850.<sup>104</sup> Property: Owned real estate valued at \$70,000; one of highest values listed in the county in 1850.<sup>105</sup> Property: slave named Betta died from burns at age 104 in Crabbottom area, Highland County, VA on 28 Mar 1857.<sup>45</sup> Occupation: Gentleman in 1860.<sup>106</sup> Location: in Crabbottom area, Highland County, VA in 1862.<sup>98</sup> Individual Note: in 1862 almost totally deaf.<sup>98</sup> Property: Owned 5 slaves valued at \$2,000 in 1862.<sup>95</sup> Property: Owned silver plate valued at \$20 in 1862.<sup>95</sup> He died on 17 Mar 1868; at the age of 87 pneumonia in Bullpasture River Valley, Highland County, VA.<sup>107-108</sup> Occupation: Grazier in 1868.<sup>45</sup> He was buried in McDowell Presbyterian Church Cemetery, McDowell, VA.<sup>75</sup> Individual Note: in Highland County, VA a "Cattle King".<sup>98</sup>
