Location: in Augusta County, VA Came from North Carolina and settled on the Calfpasture, (Augusta) Highland County, VA in 1744.¹⁻² Property: Bought 544 acres on the Calfpasture from James Patton and John Lewis on 17 Jul 1744.¹⁻³ Military: in 1758 Member of Capt. William Preston's company of Rangers.⁴ Property: sold 241 acres (of a tract of 544 acres) on the Calfpasture River to son Robert for five shillings in Augusta County, VA on 18 May 1762.⁵ Property: owns 7 horses and 12 cattle at Calfpasture in Augusta County, VA in 1782.⁶ **Robert GWIN**^{3,7-10} was born in Wales.²

Location: in Albemarle County, VA .¹⁻² Individual Note: Had 9 children.¹ **Jean KINCAID**^{1,9}, daughter of David KINCAID and Winnifred , was born (date unknown).

4. **David GWIN**^{2-3,7,10-11,23-28} (Robert-1) was born in 1742 in Wales.^{2-3,28-29} Location: Jackson's River, 1 mile from future Bath County line in 1780.³⁰ Property: owns 1 black over 16 years of age, 22 horses and 67 cattle in Augusta County, VA in 1787.²⁴ Property: Purchased the farm of John Peoples, Sr., Bullpasture, Highland County, VA in 1805.^{2,31-32} He signed a will on 18 Apr 1820 in Bath County, VA.²⁶ He died about Jan 1822; at the age of 80.^{3,29,33} Estate: on 28 Feb 1822 in Bath County, VA inventory: 13 slaves, still vessels, and other items.²⁷ David was buried in 1822 in Clover Creek Presbyterian Church Cemetery, Highland County, VA.^{29,34} Military: Officer (Captain and LT) in colonial wars.^{3,34-35} Military: Commanded a company at the Battle of Guilford Court House; he marched his militia to the aid of General Greene.^{1,7,36} Estate: Gave Tomahawk Ranch to grandson, David Gwin.³⁷

David GWIN and Jane CARLILE³⁸ were married in 1768.^{1-2,28,39} **Jane CARLILE**^{2,40-42}, daughter of James CARLILE and Nancy CAMPBELL, was born on 26 Nov 1746.⁴³⁻⁴⁴ She died in 1787; at the age of 41.^{1,28} Location: in Kentucky about 1805.⁴⁵ Individual Note: Had 9 children.¹ She was buried at near county route 611 in Jackson's River area, Highland County, VA.⁴³

David GWIN and Violet "Viola" CRAWFORD⁴⁶ were married on 11 Nov 1790.^{1,28} **Violet "Viola" CRAWFORD**^{1-3,47}, daughter of William CRAWFORD and Margaret HENDERSON, was born about 1765 in Pennsylvania.⁴⁸ She died about 1815; at the age of 50 in Augusta County, VA.⁴⁸ Individual Note: Had 5 children.¹
