1. **Richard BOTKIN**¹⁻³ was born in 1710.⁴ Property: Patented 339 acres on Clover Creek, Bullpasture River in 1743.⁵ Location: On the Bullpasture, 4 miles south of McDowell in 1746.⁶ He was elected in 1749 as Constable on the Cowpasture.² Location: Bullpasture Valley, Highland County; above Clover Creek about 1750.⁷ Individual Note: in 1751 Appointed by the court to help clear a road from Estill's mill to the head of the Calfpasture.⁸ Military: on 11 Aug 1756 On muster roll of Capt George Wilson's Company of VA milita as a private.⁵ Property: sold 339 acres at Clover Creek on the Bullpasture River to Samuel Given for five shillings in Augusta County, VA on 19 May 1762.⁹ Property: 6 acres; his mills mentioned in Bullpasture River Valley, Augusta County, VA on 8 Sep 1768.³

4. **Hugh BOTKIN**^{4,10-14} (Richard-1) was born in 1736 in Augusta County, VA.⁵ Property: 174 acres on North River in Augusta County, VA on 19 May 1761.¹⁰ Property: sold 174 acres on draft of North River to Henry Picket for five shillings in Augusta County, VA on 20 Aug 1765.¹¹ Military: in 1774 Augusta Militia under Captain Samuel Wilson.¹⁵ Property: owns 5 horses and 10 cattle in Augusta County, VA in 1787.¹⁴ He died in 1801; at the age of 65 in Knox County, TN.⁵ He signed a will in 1801 in Tennessee.¹⁶

Hugh BOTKIN and Hester FARMER were married.¹⁷ **Hester FARMER**¹⁷⁻¹⁹ was born in 1740 in Augusta County, VA.⁵ She died; in Knox County, TN.⁵

5. **John BOTKIN**^{2,4,20-24} (Richard-1) was born in 1740.⁵ Property: sold 200 acres on Newfoundland Creek to Robert Duffield for five shillings in Augusta County, VA on 17 Aug 1762.²¹ Property: purchased 100 acres from James Shaw on the Cowpasture for five shillings in Augusta County, VA on 20 Aug 1766.²⁰ Property: sold 66 acres to David Frame for fifteen pounds in Augusta County, VA on 15 Mar 1767.²² Property: purchased 66 acres from David Frame for fifteen pounds in Augusta County, VA on 19 Mar 1767.²⁵ Property: 232 acres in Bullpasture River Valley, Augusta County, VA on 15 Feb 1768.²⁶ Property: on the Bullpasture in 1768.² Location: Lived on Cowpasture river adjoining John Poage and David Bell on 8 Dec 1769.⁵ Property: purchased 114 acres from Thomas and Jane Wright for 110 pounds in Augusta County, VA on 25 Oct 1781.²⁷ Property: owns 4 horses and 11 cows in Augusta County, VA in 1787.²³ Family Note: in 1787 one white male between 16 and 21 years of age in Augusta County, VA.²³ He died in 1791; at the age of 51 in Highland County, VA.⁴⁻⁵ He signed a will in 1791.²⁸ Military: Served in the American Revolution from Augusta County, VA.⁵

6. **James BOTKIN Sr.**^{4,23,29-30} (Richard-1) was born in 1742 in Augusta County, VA.⁵ Property: purchased 216 acres on the Cowpasture River from Charles Gillham for five shillings in Augusta County, VA on 19 Apr 1763.²⁹ Property: purchased 280 acres on Land Creek from John & Agnes McCreery for five shillings in Augusta County, VA on 20 Sep 1763.³⁰ Property: sold 260 acres on Cowpasture River to Robert Carlile for five shillings in Augusta County, VA on 19 May 1767.³¹ Property: purchased 105 acres on the Cowpasture River from William Stewart for five shillings in Augusta County, VA on 15 Mar 1768.³² Property: Granted land on the Cowpasture River on 6 Oct 1770.⁵ Property: owns 3 horses and 7 cattle in Augusta County, VA in 1787.²³ He signed a will on 18 Aug 1804 in Kentucky.³³
