HAMILTON and Rachel VANCE, was born on 2 Nov 1790 in Back Creek area, Augusta County, VA.<sup>110-113</sup> Property: purchased 350 acres from William and Lanty Lockridge in Bullpasture River Valley area of Bath County, VA in 1839.<sup>114</sup> He signed a will on 10 Aug 1839 in Bath County, VA.<sup>76</sup> He died on 28 Mar 1840; at the age of 49 in Bullpasture River Valley area of Bath County, VA.<sup>112,115-118</sup> Family Note: Had no children.<sup>119</sup> Estate: Left land on the Bullpasture below Clover Creek to Margaret Wright and husband Daniel Hamilton.<sup>104</sup> Alexander was buried in Hamilton Family Cemetery, Flood, Highland County, VA.<sup>105</sup>
