1. **William STEUART**<sup>1–5</sup> was born about 1732 in Scotland.<sup>6–7</sup> Location: in Augusta County, VA at mouth of Shaw's Fork about 1755.<sup>8</sup> Property: settled just below the mouth of Shaw's Fork on the Cowpasture River; 105 acres in May 1759.<sup>9–10</sup> Property: sold 105 acres on the Cowpasture River to James Bodkin for five shillings in Augusta County, VA on 15 Mar 1768.<sup>3</sup> Property: 65 acres, adjoining James Botkin in Cowpasture River Valley, Augusta County, VA on 6 Oct 1770.<sup>4</sup> Property: owns 8 horses and 21 cattle in Augusta County, VA in 1787.<sup>11</sup> He signed a will on 27 Dec 1796 in Bath County, VA.<sup>5</sup> Estate: on 26 Mar 1797 in Bath County, VA 13 hogs, 22 cattle, 5 horses, 9 sheep, wagon, still, 1 Negro wench and child, and other items.<sup>12</sup> He died in 1797; at the age of 65.<sup>13</sup> Individual Note: Took passage on a ship that was captured by Spanish pirates.<sup>7</sup> Occupation: Schoolteacher.<sup>7</sup>

William STEUART and Margaret USHER were married in 1756.<sup>5,7,14–15</sup> **Margaret USHER**<sup>5,7,15–16</sup>, daughter of Edward USHER and PERRY, was born (date unknown).
