

## First Generation

1. Individual Note: on 13 Apr 1778 in Augusta County, VA signer of a petition to establish a new county.<sup>1</sup> Location: in Crab Run area, Highland County, VA in 1778.<sup>2</sup> Property: owned 10 horses and 21 cattle in Augusta County, VA in 1787.<sup>3</sup> Family Note: in 1787 one white male between 16 and 21 years of age in Augusta County, VA.<sup>3</sup> **Joseph BEATHE**<sup>3-4</sup> died in 1801; .<sup>4</sup>

Joseph BEATHE had the following children:

- +2 i. **James BEATHE**, married Mary Ann PULLIN, 13 Nov 1810, Bath County, VA; died Dec 1835, Pendleton County, VA.
- +3 ii. **Mary BEATHE**, married John GRIFFITH, 1805.

2. **James BEATHE**<sup>5-9</sup> (Joseph-1) died in Dec 1835; in Pendleton County, VA.<sup>10</sup> Family Note: had 17 children, all dead by mid 1907 .<sup>11</sup>

James BEATHE and Mary Ann "Polly" PULLIN were married on 13 Nov 1810 in Bath County, VA.<sup>12-13</sup> **Mary Ann "Polly" PULLIN**<sup>5,10,14-15</sup>, daughter of Samuel PULLIN and Sarah HENRY, was born about 1793 in Bath County, VA.<sup>10</sup> She died in 1858; at the age of 65 in Pendleton County, VA.<sup>4,10</sup>

James BEATHE and Mary Ann PULLIN had the following children:

- +5 ii. **James M. BEATHE**, born 1813, Pendleton County, VA; died 17 Oct 1861, Crab Run area, Highland County, VA.

BEATHE**<sup>4,16-20</sup> was born in 1815 in Pendleton County, VA.<sup>18,21-24</sup> Agriculture: in 1850 80 acres improved, 220 acres unimproved land; farm value \$2,000, machinery value \$100, livestock value \$750 in Highland County, VA<sup>25</sup> Occupation: Farmer in 1850.<sup>21</sup> Property: Owned real estate valued at \$2,000 in 1850.<sup>21</sup> Occupation: Shoemaker between 1860 and 1883.<sup>18,20,22-23</sup> Property: Owned personal property valued at \$3,343 in 1860.<sup>22</sup> Property: Owned real estate valued at \$1,751 in 1860.<sup>22</sup> Property: With brother owned 293 3/4 acres valued at \$1,813.69 in 1862.<sup>26</sup> Money at Interest: With brother listed at \$3,000 in 1862 .<sup>26</sup> Agriculture: in 1862 With brother owned 11 cattle, horses, or mules valued at \$105 .<sup>26</sup> Property: Owned personal estate valued at \$2,000 in 1870.<sup>18</sup> Property: Owned real estate valued at \$1,000 in 1870.<sup>18</sup> Illness: Listed as maimed, crippled, bedridden, or otherwise disabled in 1880 .<sup>23</sup> He died on 18 Aug 1883; at the age of 68 of dyspepsia in Crab Run area, Highland County, VA.<sup>20</sup>
- +7 iv. **Malinda B. BEATHE**, born 1818, Crab Run area, Pendleton County, VA; married James C. HICKLIN, 21 Feb 1867, Highland County, VA; died Apr 1895, Bullpasture River Valley, Highland County, VA.
- 8 v. **John M. BEATHE**<sup>4,21</sup> was born in 1821 in Pendleton County, VA.<sup>21</sup> Individual Note: Married in Pocahontas County, WV.<sup>4</sup>
- +9 vi. **Samuel P. BEATHE**, born 1823, Pendleton County, VA; died 9 Jan 1892, Crab Run area, Highland County, VA.

- 10   vii. **Eliza BEATHE**<sup>4,21,27</sup> was born in 1825 in Pendleton County, VA.<sup>21,28</sup> Occupation: House attendant in 1860.<sup>28</sup>
- 11   viii. **Frances "Fannie" BEATHE**<sup>4,19,22,29-30</sup> was born in 1826 in Bath County, VA.<sup>22-23,31-32</sup> Occupation: House attendant in 1860.<sup>22</sup> Occupation: Housekeeper in 1880.<sup>23</sup> Illness: sick with rheumatism and grip in May 1900.<sup>33</sup> She died on 21 Feb 1907; at the age of 81 at the home of her sister-in-law, Mrs. Stone.<sup>11</sup>
- 12   ix. **Robert C. BEATHE**<sup>34-35</sup> was born in 1827 in Pendleton County, VA.<sup>21</sup> Individual Note: in May 1892 found guilty of trespass and paid \$60 damage and costs.<sup>36</sup>
- +13   x. **Margaret C. BEATHE**, born 1829, Pendleton County, VA; married John WOLF, 25 Oct 1860, Highland County, VA.
- +14   xi. **Andrew J. BEATHE**, born 1830, Pendleton County, VA; married Cynthia Ann FISHER, 20 Jan 1859, Highland County, VA; died bef Jul 1860.
- 15   xii. **Peter H. BEATHE**<sup>4,37-40</sup> was born in 1832 in Pendleton County, VA.<sup>28,41-42</sup> Occupation: Farmhand in 1860.<sup>28</sup> Military: on 11 May 1861-26 Jun 1862 Company B, 31st Virginia Infantry Regiment, CSA.<sup>40</sup> He died on 26 Jun 1862; at the age of 30 of a wound in Port Republic Battle, Port Republic, VA.<sup>43-44</sup> Occupation: Farmer in 1862.<sup>45</sup> Individual Note: single.<sup>39</sup>
- 16   xiii. **William C. BEATHE**<sup>4,21,39,46</sup> was born in 1832 in Pendleton County, VA.<sup>21-22,47</sup> Occupation: Farmhand in 1860.<sup>22</sup> He died on 26 Nov 1861; at the age of 29 of typhoid fever in Crab Run area, Highland County, VA.<sup>39</sup>
- 17   xiv. **E. J. BEATHE**<sup>39</sup> was born in 1834 in Pendleton County, VA.<sup>39</sup> She died on 25 Oct 1861; at the age of 27 of pneumonia in Crab Run area, Highland County, VA.<sup>39</sup>

3. **Mary BEATHE**<sup>4</sup> (Joseph-1) was born (date unknown).

Mary BEATHE and John GRIFFITH were married in 1805.<sup>4</sup> **John GRIFFITH**<sup>4</sup> was born (date unknown).
